**Introduction:** The Apostle Paul preached “The Gospel” everywhere he went. There is only one “Bible Gospel.” The “Bible Gospel” is the message of the God Man, Jesus Christ, His virgin birth and sinless life, His vicarious death on the cross, His burial for three day, and His resurrection to life to pay the sin debt of the human race. (1 Corinthians 15:1-4)

Yet, the One Gospel is spoken of in several ways is the Bible. (Mark 1:14; Romans 1:1, 16; Romans 10:15; Ephesians 1:13)

In the text before us, The Apostle speaks of “the gospel of the grace of God.” Note the following two points about this Gospel:
